Full Time Summer Internship with New City Fellowship/HOPE for Atlantic City

Job Description (Roles & Responsibilities):

This internship includes a variety of ministry experiences and responsibilities that include but are not limited to:

- Weeknight Bible Clubs (Organize, assist, lead and debrief teams as they do evangelistic Bible clubs in local neighborhoods)
- Daily Worksite (Organize, assist, lead and debrief teams as they complete various mercy projects throughout the city... Help out HOPE director as needed)
- Campus/Facility (Organize, watch over, keep up, provide security for the building & UMT teams.
 Assist UMT teams by being with the teams in the building and on call in case of emergency or situation)
- Intern's Training and Discipleship (Participate in his/her own development as a child of God and leader in the Kingdom through talks, discussion, assigned books/articles, and formal and informal 1 on 1's with Staff, etc.)
- Attend & participate in weekly Leadership Training, Staff Meeting, and Sunday Morning Worship
- Responding appropriately to other ministry needs & responsibilities throughout the duration of the internship.
