Questions about Chapter 9

- A synagogue leader came to Jesus. What did the man want? (verses 18, 19)
- What happened to the woman who had been bleeding for twelve years? What did she do? (verses 20 – 22)
- Why were the people so noisy in the synagogue leader’s house? (verses 23 - 26)
- Jesus healed two blind men. How did he heal them? What did Jesus tell the men? (verses 28 – 31)
- What does Jesus mean when He saw that the crowds of people were like “sheep without a shepherd”? (verses 35 to 38)
- What is Jesus talking about when he says to his disciples, “Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into the harvest field.”? (verse 38)
